


### RUSH RPA TREASURER'S REPORT (CONT'D)


West of Railroad Museum and Rush Riverside Refuge



Plans to install warm season grasses

- Native plants
- Support endangered bird species

Prevents erosion


Stem cuttings inserted; new trees grow and establish a root network
